A BILL

To redesignate the dam located on the Santa Ana River as the “Victor V. Veysey Dam”.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REDESIGNATION AND REFERENCES.**

4 (a) DESIGNATION.—The dam located on the Santa
5 Ana River, commonly known as the Prado Dam as author-
6 ized by the Flood Control Act of 1936 (Public Law 74–
7 738, 49 Stat. 1570, 1589), shall be known and designated
8 as the “Victor V. Veysey Dam”.

1 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
2 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
3 States to the dam referred to in paragraph (1) shall be
4 deemed to be a reference to the “Victor V. Veysey Dam”.
