## A BILL

To repeal a provision relating to privacy officers in the

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REPEAL OF PRIVACY OFFICER PROVISION.**

4 Section 522 of the Transportation, Treasury, Inde-  
5 pendent Agencies, and General Government Appropria-  
6 tions Act, 2005 (Public Law 108–447; 118 Stat. 3268;  
7 5 U.S.C. 552a note), is hereby repealed.
