4	(a) In General.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
5	the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
6	amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
7	new heading:
	" 9902.04.22 9, 10-Anthracenedione (CAS No. 13936–21–5) (provided for in subheading 2914.69.90 in pure form or 3824.90.28 in 50% solution) Free No change No change On or before 12/31/2006 ".

8 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by

9 this section shall apply with respect to goods entered, or

- 1 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
- 2 the 15th day after the date of enactment of this Act.
