1 **SECTION 1. PROHIBITION ON OPERATION OF MEDICARE**
2 **COMPARATIVE COST ADJUSTMENT (CCA)**
3 **PROGRAM IN TEXAS.**

4 Section 1860C–1(b)(2) of the Social Security Act (42
5 U.S.C. 1395w–29(b)(2)) is amended by adding at the end
6 the following new subparagraph:

7 “(C) NO PART IN TEXAS.—No part of the
8 MSA is in Texas.”.

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
