- 7 to each of the 17 plaintiffs in the case of Acree v. Republic

- 2 captive by Iraq during the first Gulf War.
- 3 (b) Source of Funds.—\$17,000,000 shall be avail-
- 4 able, from unobligated funds appropriated under chapter
- 5 2 of title II of the Emergency Supplemental Appropria-
- 6 tions Act for Defense and for the Reconstruction of Iraq
- 7 and Afghanistan, 2004, under the heading "OTHER BI-
- 8 LATERAL ECONOMIC ASSISTANCE—FUNDS AP-
- 9 PROPRIATED TO THE PRESIDENT—IRAQ RELIEF AND RE-
- 10 CONSTRUCTION FUND", for payments under subsection
