## A BILL

To amend the Trade Sanctions Reform and Export Enhancement Act of 2000 to clarify allowable payment terms for sales of agricultural commodities and products to Cuba.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. CLARIFICATION OF PAYMENT TERMS FOR**  
2 **SALES OF AGRICULTURAL COMMODITIES**  
3 **AND PRODUCTS TO CUBA UNDER THE TRADE**  
4 **SANCTIONS REFORM AND EXPORT ENHANCE-**  
5 **MENT ACT OF 2000.**

6 Subparagraph (A) of section 908(b)(1) of the Trade  
7 Sanctions Reform and Export Enhancement Act of 2000  
8 (22 U.S.C. 7207(b)(1)(A)) is amended to read as follows:

9 “(A) Payment of cash in advance, which as  
10 used herein means the payment by the pur-  
11 chaser of an agricultural commodity or product  
12 and the receipt of such payment by the seller  
13 prior to—

14 “(i) the transfer of title of such com-  
15 modity or product to the purchaser; and

16 “(ii) the release of control of such  
17 commodity or product to the purchaser.”.
