A BILL

To amend title 28, United States Code, to enable the Supreme Court to review decisions in which the Court of Appeals for the Armed Forces denied relief.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Equal Justice for Our
5 Military Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. SUPREME COURT REVIEW OF DECISIONS IN WHICH**
2 **THE COURT OF APPEALS FOR THE ARMED**
3 **FORCES DENIED RELIEF.**

4 Section 1259 of title 28, United States Code, is
5 amended in paragraph (4) by striking “granted relief” and
6 inserting “granted or denied relief”.
