## A BILL

To provide that Executive Order 13166 shall have no force or effect, and to prohibit the use of funds for certain purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. NULLIFICATION OF EFFECT OF EXECUTIVE**  
4 **ORDER.**

5 Executive Order 13166, “Improving Access to Serv-  
6 ices for Persons with Limited English Proficiency” (Au-  
7 gust 16, 2000; 65 Fed. Reg. 50121), is null and void and  
8 shall have no force or effect.

1 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION AGAINST USE OF FUNDS FOR CER-**  
2 **TAIN PURPOSES.**

3 No funds appropriated pursuant to any provision of  
4 law may be used to promulgate or enforce any executive  
5 order that creates an entitlement to services provided in  
6 any language other than English.
