- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "FHA Single Family
- 5 Loan Limit Adjustment Act of 2005".
- 6 SEC. 2. FHA SINGLE FAMILY HOUSING MAXIMUM MORT-
- 7 GAGE LIMIT.
- 8 Section 203(b)(2)(A) of the National Housing Act
- 9 (12 U.S.C. 1709(b)(2)(A)) is amended—
- 10 (1) in clause (i), by striking "95 percent" and
- inserting "100 percent";

1	(2) in clause (ii)—
2	(A) by striking "87 percent" and insert-
3	ing "100 percent"; and
4	(B) by striking "for Fiscal Year" and in-
5	serting a comma; and
6	(3) by moving subparagraph (A), including
7	clauses (i) and (ii) of such subparagraph, 2 ems to
8	the right.
