## A BILL

To extend the temporary duty suspension on C12–18  
Alkenes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. C12–18 ALKENES.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of  
5 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is  
6 amended by striking heading 9902.03.86 and inserting the  
7 following:

“	9902.03.86	C12–18 alkenes, polymers (TPX) with 4-methyl-1-pentene (CAS Nos. 25155–83–3, 81229–87–0, and 103908–22–1) (provided for in subheading 3902.90.00) ..	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2008	”.

1       (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by  
2 this section shall apply with respect to goods entered, or  
3 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after  
4 the 15th day after the date of the enactment of this Act.
