## A BILL

To improve national pier inspections and safety standards.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 To be supplied.
- 5 SEC. 2. STANDARDS.
- 6 Not later than 180 days after the date of enactment
- 7 of this Act, the Secretary of the Army, acting through the
- 8 Chief of Engineers, shall establish standards and regula-
- 9 tions regarding the inspection and safety of piers and wa-
- 10 terfront structures. To assist in the development of such
- 11 standards and regulations, the Chief of Engineers shall
- 12 use as a guide, bill number 020310, adopted by the City

- 1 of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, which amends title 4 of the
- 2 Philadelphia Code (the Philadelphia Building Construc-
- 3 tion and Occupancy Code).
- 4 SEC. 3. ELIGIBILITY FOR FUNDS.
- 5 To be eligible to receive funds for a project funded
- 6 through the Army Corps of Engineers each State shall
- 7 provide annual documentation to the Chief of Engineers
- 8 that the State has adopted and is enforcing standards and
- 9 regulations that are at least as rigorous as those estab-
- 10 lished pursuant to section 2.
- 11 SEC. 4. REPORTS.
- Beginning in January of 2007, and each year there-
- 13 after, the Chief of Engineers shall submit a report to the
- 14 appropriate Committees of Congress regarding State com-
- 15 pliance with pier and waterfront inspection and safety.
- 16 SEC. 5. EFFECTIVE DATE.
- 17 This Act shall apply to projects to be funded through
- 18 the Army Corps of Engineers beginning in 2007.
