A BILL

To direct the Secretary of the Army to review a report of the Chief of Engineers regarding flooding in the Delaware River.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the Secretary of the Army, acting through the Chief
4 of Engineers, shall review, in consultation with the Dela-
5 ware River Basin Commission and the States of Delaware,
6 Pennsylvania, New Jersey, and New York, the report of
7 the Chief of Engineers on the Delaware River, published
8 as House Document Numbered 522, 87th Congress, Sec-
9 ond Session, as it relates to the Mid-Delaware River Basin

1 from Wilmington to Port Jervis, and any other pertinent
2 reports (including the strategy for resolution of interstate
3 flow management issues in the Delaware River Basin
4 dated August 2004 and the National Park Service Lower
5 Delaware River Management Plan (1997–1999)), with a
6 view to determining whether any modifications of rec-
7 ommendations contained in such report are advisable at
8 the present time, in the interest of flood damage reduc-
9 tion, ecosystem restoration, and other related problems.
