A BILL

To amend the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States to clarify the article description relating to certain monochrome glass envelopes, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CERTAIN MONOCHROME GLASS ENVELOPES.**

4 (a) AMENDMENT TO SUBHEADING 7011.20.40 OF
5 HTSUS.—The article description of subheading
6 7011.20.40 of the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the
7 United States is amended to read as follows: “Mono-
8 chrome glass envelopes, the foregoing certified by the im-

1 porter as being for actual use in automatic data processing
2 machine data or graphic display cathode ray tubes”.

3 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.—(1) Subheading
4 7011.20.40 of the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the
5 United States, as amended by subsection (a), is redesign-
6 nated as subheading 7011.20.45.

7 (2) Subheading 7011.20.80 of such Schedule is redes-
8 igned as subheading 7011.20.85.

9 (3) Subchapter II of chapter 99 of such Schedule is
10 amended by striking heading 9902.70.01.

11 (c) STAGED RATE REDUCTIONS.—Any staged rate
12 reduction of a rate of duty proclaimed by the President
13 before the date of the enactment of this Act, that—

14 (1) would take effect on or after such date of
15 enactment; and

16 (2) would, but for the amendment made by sub-
17 section (b)(2), apply to subheading 7011.20.80 of
18 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United
19 States,

20 applies to the corresponding rate of duty set forth in sub-
21 heading 7011.20.85 of such Schedule (as added by sub-
22 section (b)(2)).
