To suspend temporarily the duty on butylated
hydroxyethylbenzene.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. BUTYLATED HYDROXYETHYLBENZENE.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
5 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
6 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
7 new heading:

“	9902.04.40	2,6-Di- <i>tert</i> -butyl-4-ethylphenol (CAS No. 4130-42-1) (provided for in sub-heading 2907.19.80)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2008	”.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
2 subsection (a) applies to articles entered, or withdrawn
3 from warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day
4 after the date of the enactment of this Act.
