## A BILL

To extend the temporary duty suspension on Ezetimibe.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. EZETIMIBE.**

4       (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.01.64 of the Har-  
5       monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to  
6       2-Azetidinone,                   1-(4-fluorophenyl)-3-[(3S)-3-(4-  
7       fluorophenyl)-3-hydroxypropyl]-4-(4-hydroxyphenyl)-,  
8       (3R,4S)-(Ezetimibe)) is amended by striking “12/31/  
9       2006” and inserting “12/31/2008”.

10       (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by  
11       subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from

- 1 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
- 2 the date of the enactment of this Act.
