A BILL

To amend the Safe Drinking Water Act to require a national primary drinking water regulation for perchlorate.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Safe Drinking Water
- 5 for Healthy Communities Act of 2005".
- 6 SEC. 2. NATIONAL PRIMARY DRINKING WATER REGULA-
- 7 TION FOR PERCHLORATE.
- 8 Section 1412(b)(12) of the Safe Drinking Water Act
- 9 (42 U.S.C. 300g-1(b)(12)) is amended by adding at the
- 10 end the following:

1	"(C) Perchlorate.—
2	"(i) Schedule and standard.—
3	Notwithstanding the deadlines set forth in
4	paragraph (1), the Administrator shal
5	promulgate a national primary drinking
6	water regulation for perchlorate pursuant
7	to this subsection, in accordance with the
8	schedule established by this subparagraph
9	"(ii) Proposed regulations.—No
10	later than January 31, 2006, the Adminis
11	trator shall propose a national primary
12	drinking water regulation for percholate.
13	"(iii) Final regulations.—No
14	later than July 31, 2007, after notice and
15	opportunity for public comment, the Ad-
16	ministrator shall promulgate a nationa
17	primary drinking water regulation for per-
18	chlorate.".
