2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. TREATMENT OF INTERNMENT OF REMAINS IN**
2 **AN AMERICAN BATTLE MONUMENTS COMMIS-**
3 **SION CEMETERY AS UNAVAILABLE FOR THE**
4 **PURPOSES OF PLACEMENT OF MEMORIAL**
5 **MARKERS IN NATIONAL CEMETERIES.**

6 Paragraph (3) of section 2306(b) of title 38, United
7 States Code, is amended—

8 (1) by striking “or” at the end of subparagraph
9 (C);

10 (2) by striking the period at the end of sub-
11 paragraph (D) and inserting “; or”; and

12 (3) by adding at the end the following new sub-
13 paragraph:

14 “(E) are interred in an American Battle Monu-
15 ments Commission cemetery.”.
