## A BILL

To prohibit the Federal Communications Commission from requiring digital television tuners in television receivers.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "TV Consumer Choice
- 5 Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON REQUIRING DIGITAL TELEVISION
- 7 TUNERS IN TELEVISION RECEIVERS.
- 8 (a) Prohibition.—Neither section 303(s) of the
- 9 Communications Act of 1934 (47 U.S.C. 303(s)) nor any
- 10 other provision of such Act shall be construed to authorize

- 1 the Federal Communications Commission to require, or
- 2 prescribe any schedule for the implementation of, digital
- 3 television reception capability in television broadcast re-
- 4 ception equipment.
- 5 (b) Commission Actions Nullified.—The require-
- 6 ments and schedule established by the Commission for the
- 7 implementation of digital television reception capability in
- 8 television broadcast reception equipment as contained in
- 9 section 15.117(i) of the Commission's regulations (47
- 10 CFR 15.117(i)) as modified in FCC 02-230 (August 8,
- 11 2002), shall not be effective except as expressly hereafter
- 12 provided by Act of Congress.
