A BILL

To amend title 38, United States Code, to extend the time limitation for use of eligibility and entitlement for educational assistance under the Montgomery GI Bill.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Montgomery GI Bill
5 Flexibility Act of 2005”.

1 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF TIME LIMITATION FOR USE OF**
2 **MONTGOMERY GI BILL ENTITLEMENT.**

3 (a) **EXTENSION OF LIMITATION PERIOD.**—Section
4 3031 of title 38, United States Code, is amended by strik-
5 ing “10-year” each place it appears and inserting “14-
6 year”.

7 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE AND APPLICABILITY.**—The
8 amendment made by subsection (a) shall take effect on
9 the date of the enactment of this Act, and shall apply to
10 individuals whose entitlement to educational assistance
11 under chapter 30 of title 38, United States Code, has not
12 expired as of such date under the provisions of section
13 3031 of such title as in effect on the date preceding such
14 date of enactment.
