1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CONTINUATION OF MISSION OF THE DEPART-**
4 **MENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS MEDICAL CEN-**
5 **TER IN KERRVILLE, TEXAS.**

6 Except as otherwise expressly authorized by law, the
7 Secretary of Veterans Affairs—

1 (1) may not implement a change in the mission
2 of the Department of Veterans Affairs medical cen-
3 ter in Kerrville, Texas; and

4 (2) shall continue to maintain a minimum of 25
5 acute care beds at that medical center.
