## A BILL

1	Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

3	SECTION 1. IPN (ISOPHTHALONITRILE).
4	(a) Calendar Year 2006.—
5	(1) In general.—Subchapter II of chapter 99
6	of the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United
7	States is amended by inserting in numerical se-
8	quence the following new heading:
	" 9902.09.11 1,3-Benzenedicarbonitrile (CAS No. 626–17–5) (provided for in subheading 2926.90.48)

1	(2) Effective date.—The amendment made
2	by paragraph (1) applies to goods entered, or with-
3	drawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
4	the 15th day after the date of enactment of this Act.
5	(b) Calendar Year 2007.—
6	(1) In General.—Heading 9902.09.11 of the
7	Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States, as
8	added by subsection (a), is amended—
9	(A) by striking "3.04%" and inserting
10	"3.23%"; and
11	(B) by striking "On or before 12/31/2006"
12	and inserting "On or before 12/31/2007".
13	(2) Effective date.—The amendments made
14	by paragraph (1) shall take effect on January 1,
15	2007.
16	(c) Calendar Year 2008.—
17	(1) In General.—Heading 9902.09.11 of the
18	Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States, as
19	added by subsection (a) and amended by this sec-
20	tion, is further amended—
21	(A) by striking "3.23%" and inserting
22	"3.4%"; and
23	(B) by striking "On or before 12/31/2007"
24	and inserting "On or before 12/31/2008".

1 (2) Effective date.—The amendments made 2 by paragraph (1) shall take effect on January 1, 3 2008.
