Mr. LARSEN of Washington introduced the following bill; which was referred

A BILL

To modify the boundary of the San Juan Island National
Historical Park.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “San Juan Island Na-
5 tional Historical Park Boundary Addition Act of 2005”.

6 **SEC. 2. ADDITION TO BOUNDARY OF PEAK.**

7 The first section of the Act of September 9, 1966
8 (Public Law 89–565; 80 Stat 737; 16 U.S.C. 282a) is
9 amended—

10 (1) by striking “That the” and inserting the
11 following:

1 “SECTION 1. (a) The”; and

2 (2) by adding after subsection (a) (as so redes-
3 ignated by paragraph (1)) the following new sub-
4 section:

5 “(b) The Secretary of the Interior is authorized to
6 acquire, by donation or exchange only, the property known
7 as the Mitchell Hill, as generally depicted on the map enti-
8 tled ‘ _____’, num-
9 bered _____, and dated _____. The map
10 shall be on file and available for inspection in the appro-
11 priate offices of the National Park Service.”.

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
