A BILL

To extend the temporary suspension of duty on yarn of
combed Kashmir (cashmere) and yarn of camel hair.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. YARN OF COMBED KASHMIR (CASHMERE) OR**
4 **YARN OF CAMEL HAIR.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.03.01 of the Har-
6 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to
7 yarn of combed Kashmir (cashmere) or yarn of camel
8 hair) is amended by striking “12/31/2006” and inserting
9 “12/31/2008”.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
2 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
3 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
4 the date of enactment of this Act.
