- 3 SECTION 1. CERTAIN YARN OF CARDED KASHMIR (CASH-
- 4 MERE).
- 5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.03.02 of the Har-
- 6 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to
- 7 certain yarn of carded Kashmir (cashmere)) is amended
- 8 as follows:

- 1 (1) By striking "of 6 run or finer (equivalent 2 to 19.35 metric yarn system)" and inserting "of 3 19.35 metric yarn count or finer".
- 4 (2) By striking "12/31/2006" and inserting 5 "12/31/2008".
- 6 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
 7 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
 8 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
 9 the date of enactment of this Act.
