Mr. SIMMONS introduced the following bill; which was referred to the
Committee on Ways and Means

A BILL

To extend the temporary suspension of duty on certain yarn
of carded Kashmir (cashmere).

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CERTAIN YARN OF CARDED KASHMIR (CASH-**
4 **MERE).**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.03.02 of the Har-
6 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to
7 certain yarn of carded Kashmir (cashmere)) is amended
8 as follows:

1 (1) By striking “of 6 run or finer (equivalent
2 to 19.35 metric yarn system)” and inserting “of
3 19.35 metric yarn count or finer”.

4 (2) By striking “12/31/2006” and inserting
5 “12/31/2008”.

6 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
7 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
8 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
9 the date of enactment of this Act.
