1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION** 1. **2METHYL-4,6-**
4 **BIS[(OCTYLTHIO)METHYL]PHENOL.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.32.14 of the Har-
6 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to
7 2methyl-4,6-bis[(octylthio)methyl]phenol) is amended by
8 striking “12/31/2006” and inserting “12/31/2008”.

9 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
10 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from

- 1 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
- 2 the date of the enactment of this Act.
