- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, 3 **SECTION** 1. 2METHYL-4,6-4 BIS[(OCTYLTHIO)METHYL]PHENOL. 5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.32.14 of the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to 6 7 2methyl-4,6-bis[(octylthio)methyl]phenol) is amended by striking "12/31/2006" and inserting "12/31/2008". 8
- 9 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by 10 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from

- 1 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
- 2 the date of the enactment of this Act.
