A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on steel leaf spring leaves.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. STEEL LEAF SPRING LEAVES.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
5 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
6 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
7 new heading:

“	9902.73.21	Leaf spring leaves of alloy steel of grades SAE5160, SAE5160H or SAE51B60H, each measuring from 132 cm to 163 cm in length and approximately 10.2 cm in width (provided for in subheading 7320.10.60), the foregoing for multi-leaf or taper-leaf construction units, each leaf weighing from 40.8 kg to 113.4 kg and designed for use in Class 7 and 8 trucks only	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2009	”.

1 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by
 2 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
 3 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
 4 the date of the enactment of this Act.
