## A BILL

To amend title 10, United States Code, to require emergency contraception to be available at all military health care treatment facilities.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. REQUIREMENT TO MAKE AVAILABLE EMER-
- 4 GENCY CONTRACEPTION AT ALL MILITARY
- 5 HEALTH CARE TREATMENT FACILITIES.
- 6 Section 1074g(a) of title 10, United States Code, is
- 7 amended by adding at the end the following new para-
- 8 graph:
- 9 "(9)(A) Emergency contraception shall be included
- 10 on the basic core formulary of the uniform formulary.

- 1 "(B) Notwithstanding paragraph (4), no prior au-
- 2 thorization may be required for emergency contraception.
- 3 Nothing in the preceding sentence may be construed as
- 4 waiving any provision of the Federal Food, Drug, and Cos-
- 5 metic Act (21 U.S.C. 301 et seq.) or any other provision
- 6 of law administered by the Food and Drug Administra-
- 7 tion, including rules and orders of such Administration
- 8 under such Act or other provisions of law.
- 9 "(C) In this paragraph, the term 'emergency contra-
- 10 ception' means a drug, drug regimen, or device that is—
- 11 "(i) approved by the Food and Drug Adminis-
- tration to prevent pregnancy; and
- "(ii) used postcoitally.".
