Mr. WYNN introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

For the relief of Web's Construction Company, Incorporated.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PAYMENT FOR CONSTRUCTION WORK.**

4 The Secretary of the Treasury shall pay, out of any
5 money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, to
6 Web's Construction Company, Incorporated, a company
7 incorporated in the State of Maryland, \$262,500, plus a
8 reasonable rate of interest (as determined by the Sec-
9 retary) for the period beginning February 1, 1990, and
10 ending on the date of such payment, for construction work
11 performed for the benefit of the Corps of Engineers in
12 connection with Contract No. DACA31-88-C-0316. Pay-

1 ment of the sum shall be in full satisfaction of any claim
2 of Web's Construction Company, Incorporated, against
3 the United States in connection with the construction
4 work.

5 **SEC. 2. LIMITATION ON ATTORNEY FEES.**

6 It shall be unlawful for an amount exceeding 10 per-
7 cent of the amount paid pursuant to section 1 to be paid
8 to, or received by, any agent or attorney for any service
9 rendered in connection with the claim described in section
10 1. Any person who violates this section shall be guilty of
11 an infraction, and shall be subject to a fine in the amount
12 provided in title 18, United States Code.
