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SEC. 2. WAIVER OF 24-MONTH WAITING PERIOD FOR MEDI-
CARE COVERAGE OF DISABLED INDIVIDUALS
WHO ARE TERMINALLY ILL.
(a) IN GENERAL.—Section 226(h) of the Social Secu-
rity Act (42 U.S.C. 426(h)) is amended—
(1) by inserting "(A)" before "in the case"; and
(2) by inserting after "(ALS)" the following:
"and (B) in the case of an individual whom a physi-
cian has certified in writing as being terminally ill
(within the meaning of section $1861(dd)(3)(A)$) and
for whom the Secretary has made a determination
that the requirements of subsection (b) (relating to
24 months of entitlement to benefits or other status)
would otherwise work an undue hardship on such in-
dividual, as determined on the basis of criteria es-
tablished by the Secretary''.
(b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
this Act shall apply to benefits for months beginning after

19 90 days after the date of the enactment of this Act.
