6 Act (33 U.S.C. 1346(i)) is amended by inserting before

7 the period at the end the following: “and \$35,000,000 for

8 each of fiscal years 2006 through 2010”.

1 **SEC. 2. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

2 Section 8 of the Beaches Environmental Assessment
3 and Coastal Health Act of 2000 (114 Stat. 877) is amend-
4 ed by striking “2005” and inserting “2010”.
