## A BILL

To amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to repeal the cap on the cover over of tax on distilled spirits to Puerto Rico and the Virgin Islands.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. REPEAL OF CAP ON COVER OVER OF TAX ON**  
4                       **DISTILLED SPIRITS TO PUERTO RICO AND**  
5                       **VIRGIN ISLANDS.**

6       (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 7652 of the Internal Rev-  
7       enue Code of 1986 (relating to limitation on cover over  
8       of tax on distilled spirits) is amended by striking sub-  
9       section (f) and by redesignating subsections (g) and (h)  
10      as subsections (f) and (g), respectively.

1       (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—Section 7652(f) of  
2 such Code (as so redesignated) is amended by striking  
3 “subsection (f) of this section” in paragraph (1)(B) and  
4 inserting “section 5001(a)(1)”.

5       (c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by  
6 this section shall take effect on January 1, 2005.
