3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Drug Testing Integrity
- 5 Act of 2005".

6 SEC. 2. BAN OF PRODUCTS DESIGNED TO DEFRAUD DRUG 7 TESTS.

8 (a) CONDUCT PROHIBITED.—It shall be unlawful to
9 knowingly manufacture, market, sell, ship, or otherwise
10 provide to another individual any product with the intent

1 to assist such other individual to use such product to de-2 fraud a drug test.

3 (b) DEFINITION.—As used in this Act, the term "de4 fraud a drug test" means—

5 (1) submit a substance that purports to be from
6 an individual other than its actual source, or pur7 ports to have been excreted or collected other than
8 when it was actually excreted or collected; or

9 (2) engage in any other conduct with the intent
10 to produce a false or misleading outcome of a test
11 for the presence of a controlled substance.

12 SEC. 3. ENFORCEMENT BY THE FEDERAL TRADE COMMIS-13 SION.

(a) UNFAIR AND DECEPTIVE ACT OR PRACTICE.—
A violation of section 2 shall be treated as a violation of
a rule defining an unfair or deceptive act or practice prescribed under section 18(a)(1)(B) of the Federal Trade
Commission Act (15 U.S.C. 57a(a)(1)(B)).

(b) ENFORCEMENT AUTHORITY.—The Federal
Trade Commission shall enforce this Act in the same manner, by the same means, and with the same jurisdiction
as though all applicable terms and provisions of the Federal Trade Commission Act were incorporated into and
made a part of this Act.
