## A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on certain plain woven fabrics.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. CERTAIN PLAIN WOVEN FABRICS.**

4       (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of  
5       the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is  
6       amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following  
7       new heading:

“	9902.54.01	Plain woven fabrics, composed of man-made fiber textile materials, which have been coated, covered or impregnated with resoreinol formaldehyde latex (provided for in subheading 5407.10.00) .....	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2008	”

1        (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by  
2 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or  
3 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after  
4 the 15th day after the date of the enactment of this Act.
