2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. 1-ACETYL-4-(3-DODECYL-2,5-DIOXO-1-**
4 **PYRROLIDINYL)-2,2,6,6-**
5 **TETRAMETHYLPIPERIDINE.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.04.06 of the Har-
7 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to
8 1-Acetyl-4-(3-dodecyl-2,5-dioxo-1-pyrrolidinyl)-2,2,6,6-
9 tetramethylpiperidine) is amended by striking “12/31/
10 2006” and inserting “12/31/2008”.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
2 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
3 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
4 the date of the enactment of this Act.
