A BILL

To reduce temporarily the duty on formulated product
KROVAR IDF.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. FORMULATED PRODUCT KROVAR I DF .**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
5 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
6 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
7 new heading:

“	9902.05.94	Formulated product KROVAR I DF containing active ingredients: [5-bromo-3- sec-butyl-6- methyluracil] (a.k.a. bromacil) and [3-(3,4- dichlorophenyl) 1,1-dimethylurea] (a.k.a. diuron) and application adjuvants. (CAS Nos. 330–54–1 and 314–40–9) (provided for in subheading 3808.30.15)	2.5%	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2008	”.
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1 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by
 2 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
 3 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
 4 the date of enactment of this Act.
