1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF THE RECLAMATION STATES**  
2 **EMERGENCY DROUGHT RELIEF ACT OF 1991.**

3 *The Reclamation States Emergency Drought Relief Act*  
4 *of 1991 (43 U.S.C. 2210 et seq.) is amended—*

5 *(1) in section 104(c), by striking “September 30,*  
6 *2005” and inserting “September 30, 2010”; and*

7 *(2) in section 301, by striking “fiscal years 1992,*  
8 *1993, 1994, 1995, 1996, 1999, 2000, 2001, 2002,*  
9 *2003, and 2004” and inserting “the period of fiscal*  
10 *years 2006 through 2010”.*
