## A BILL

To amend the Crow Boundary Settlement Act of 1994 regarding the distribution of capital gains from the Crow Tribal Trust Fund.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. CROW TRIBAL TRUST FUND.**

4       Section 6(d) of the Crow Boundary Settlement Act  
5       of 1994 (25 U.S.C. 1776d(d)), is amended—

6               (1) in the subsection heading, by inserting “and  
7       Capital Gains” after “Interest”;

8               (2) in paragraph (1), by striking “Only” and  
9       inserting “Except as provided in paragraph (4),  
10       only”; and

1           (3) by adding at the end the following:

2           “(4) DISTRIBUTION OF CAPITAL GAINS.—Not-  
3           withstanding subsection (f), capital gains and any  
4           other noninterest income received on funds in the  
5           Crow Tribal Trust Fund shall be available for dis-  
6           tribution by the Secretary to the Crow Tribe to the  
7           extent that the balance in the Crow Tribal Trust  
8           Fund (including capital gains) exceeds 85,000,000,  
9           for the same uses and subject to the same restric-  
10          tions in paragraphs (1) and (3) as are applicable to  
11          distributions of interest.”.
