## A BILL

To require a study and report regarding the construction and designation of a new interstate highway from Savanah, Georgia, to Knoxville, Tennessee.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-  
2       tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

**3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Interstate 3/3rd Infan-  
5       try Division Highway Initiation Act of 2005”.

**6 SEC. 2. FINDING.**

7       Congress finds the following:

8               (1) Consistent with the original purposes of the  
9       Dwight D. Eisenhower National System of Inter-  
10       state and Defense Highways there is a need for a di-

1       rect interstate highway link between Fort Gordon,  
2       Eisenhower Army Regional Medical Center, the Au-  
3       gusta Veterans Administration Hospitals, Fort  
4       Stewart, Hunter Army Airfield, and the Port of Sa-  
5       vannah which is in the strategic defense interest of  
6       the Nation.

7                   (2) East Georgia, Western North Carolina, and  
8       the Great Smoky Mountains region of Tennessee are  
9       underserved by north-south interstate highways, and  
10      would benefit economically and through increased  
11      public safety by establishment of an interstate high-  
12      way extending from Savannah, Georgia, to Knox-  
13      ville, Tennessee, following a route generally defined  
14      through Sylvania, Waynesboro, Augusta, Lincolnton,  
15      Elberton, Hartwell, Toccoa, and Young Harris,  
16      Georgia; and Maryville, Tennessee.

17                   (3) The United States Army 3rd Infantry Divi-  
18      sion of Fort Stewart, Georgia provided the “Tip of  
19      the Spear” in the War on Terror in Iraq. This Divi-  
20      sion sacrificed their blood and lives so that their fel-  
21      low Americans can live in peace and freedom. These  
22      soldiers conquered Najaf, seized Saddam Inter-  
23      national Airport and Saddam Hussein’s palaces, and  
24      led the fighting on the day of Baghdad’s historic lib-  
25      eration.

## 10 SEC. 3. STUDY AND REPORT.

11 Not later than December 31, 2005, the Secretary of  
12 Transportation shall study and report to the appropriate  
13 committees of Congress regarding the steps and estimated  
14 funding necessary to designate and construct a new inter-  
15 state highway (Interstate Route I-3) for the 3rd Infantry  
16 Division 6 Highway, from Savannah, Georgia to Knoxville,  
17 Tennessee 7 (formerly the Savannah River Parkway).
