A BILL

To extend the temporary reduction in duty on certain
educational devices.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CERTAIN EDUCATIONAL DEVICES.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.85.43 of the Har-
5 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to
6 certain educational devices) is amended—

7 (1) by striking “1.67%” and inserting “Free”;
8 and

9 (2) in the effective period column, by striking
10 “12/31/2006” and inserting “12/31/2008”.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
2 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
3 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
4 the date of enactment of this Act.
