- 3 SECTION 1. REQUIREMENT FOR 12 OPERATIONAL AIR-
- 4 CRAFT CARRIERS WITHIN NAVAL FORCES OF
- 5 THE NAVY.
- 6 Section 5062 of title 10, United States Code, is
- 7 amended—

1	(1) by redesignating subsections (b) and (c) as
2	subsections (c) and (d), respectively; and
3	(2) by inserting after subsection (a) the fol-
4	lowing new subsection (b):
5	"(b) The naval combat forces of the Navy shall in-
6	clude not less than 12 operational aircraft carriers. For
7	purposes of this subsection, an operational aircraft carrier
8	includes an aircraft carrier that is temporarily unavailable
9	for worldwide deployment due to routine or scheduled
0	maintenance or repair "
