- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Pursuit of Inter-
- 5 national Education Act of 2005".

5	No funds available to the Department of the Treas-
6	ury may be used to implement, administer, or enforce the
7	amendments made to paragraphs (a) and (b) of section
8	515.565 of title 31, Code of Federal Regulations (relating
9	to specific licenses for United States academic institutions
10	and other specific licenses), as published in the Federal
11	Register on June 16, 2004 (69 Fed. Reg. 33772). The
12	limitation in the preceding sentence shall not apply to the
13	implementation, administration, or enforcement of section
14	515.560(c)(3) of title 31, Code of Federal Regulations.
