5 (a) EXTENSION OF POLICIES.—Section 44302(f)(1)
6 of title 49, United States Code, is amended by striking
7 “August 31, 2005, and shall extend through December 31,
8 2005,” in paragraph (1) and inserting “August 31, 2008,
9 and shall extend through December 31, 2008,”.

10 (b) EXTENSION OF TERRORISM COVERAGE.—Section
11 44303(b) of title 49, United States Code, is amended by

1 striking “December 31, 2005,” and inserting “December
2 31, 2008,”.
