3 **SECTION 1. TEMPORARY EXTENSION OF SUSPENSION OF**
4 **DUTY.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.05.11 of sub-
6 chapter II of chapter 99 of the Harmonized Tariff Sched-
7 ule of the United States, relating to 3,3',4,4'-
8 Biphenyltetracarboxylic Dianhydride (CAS # 2420–87–3)
9 is amended by striking 12/31/2006 and inserting 12/31/
10 2009.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
2 this subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered,
3 or withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
4 the 15th day after the date of enactment of this Act.
