2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TERMINATION OF DESIGNATION OF BRAZIL AS**
4 **A BENEFICIARY DEVELOPING COUNTRY FOR**
5 **PURPOSES OF TITLE V OF THE TRADE ACT**
6 **OF 1974.**

7 In accordance with subsections (d) and (f)(2) of sec-
8 tion 502 of the Trade Act of 1974 (19 U.S.C. 2462(d)
9 and (f)(2)), the President shall terminate the designation
10 of Brazil as a beneficiary developing country for purposes

1 of title V of the Trade Act of 1974 (19 U.S.C. 2461 et
2 seq.; relating to generalized system of preferences), effec-
3 tive not later than 90 days after the date of the enactment
4 of this Act.
