## A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on Styrene, ar-ethyl-, polymer with  
divinylbenzene and styrene (6CI) beads with

2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. STYRENE, AR-ETHYL-, POLYMER WITH**  
4                       **DIVINYLBENZENE AND STYRENE (6CI) BEADS**  
5                       **WITH LOW ASH.**

6       (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of  
7       the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is  
8       amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following  
9       new heading:

“	9902.11.09	Styrene, ar-ethyl-, polymer with divinylbenzene and styrene (6CI) beads with low ash (CAS No. 9052–95–3) (provided for in subheading 3903.90.50) .....	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2008	”.

1           (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by  
2 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from  
3 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
