A BILL

For the relief of Luis Nava, Yuliana Huicochea, Oscar Corona, and Jaime Damian.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, 3 SECTION 1. WAIVER OF GROUNDS FOR REMOVAL OF, OR 4 DENIAL OF ADMISSION TO, LUIS NAVA, 5 YULIANA HUICOCHEA, OSCAR CORONA, AND 6 JAIME DAMIAN. 7 (a) In General.—Notwithstanding sections 212(a) and 237(a) of the Immigration and Nationality Act, Luis Nava, Yuliana Huicochea, Oscar Corona, and Jaime Damian may not be removed from the United States, de-

- 1 nied admission to the United States, or considered ineli-
- 2 gible for lawful permanent residence in the United States,
- 3 by reason of any ground for removal or denial of admission
- 4 that is reflected in the records of the Department of
- 5 Homeland Security, the Immigration and Naturalization
- 6 Service of the Department of Justice, or the Visa Office
- 7 of the Department of State, on the date of the enactment
- 8 of this Act.
- 9 (b) Rescission of Outstanding Order of Re-
- 10 MOVAL.—The Secretary of Homeland Security, or the At-
- 11 torney General, as appropriate, shall rescind any out-
- 12 standing order of removal or deportation, or any finding
- 13 of deportability, that has been entered against Luis Nava,
- 14 Yuliana Huicochea, Oscar Corona, and Jaime Damian by
- 15 reason of any ground described in subsection (a).
