- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "President Ronald
- 5 Reagan \$10 Bill Act".

1	SEC. 2. LIKENESS OF PRESIDENT REAGAN REQUIRED TO
2	BE INCLUDED ON THE FACE OF \$10 FEDERAL
3	RESERVE NOTES.
4	The 8th undesignated paragraph of section 16 of the
5	Federal Reserve Act (12 U.S.C. 418) is amended by add-
6	ing at the end the following new sentence: "The face of
7	\$10 Federal reserve notes printed after December 31,
8	2005, shall bear the likeness of President Ronald Wilson
9	Reagan''.
