## A BILL

To require the National Park Service to make necessary safety improvements to the Statue of Liberty and to fully reopen the Statue to the public.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS REQUIRED.**

4 (a) **SHORT TITLE.**—This section may be cited as the  
5 “Save the Statue of Liberty Act”.

6 (b) **REQUIREMENT FOR SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS.**—  
7 Not later than September 11, 2005, the Secretary of the  
8 Interior, acting through the National Park Service and  
9 using funds available to the Secretary for this purpose,

1 shall commence necessary safety and other related im-  
2 provements to the Statue of Liberty so that it may be fully  
3 reopened to the public to provide the same access as before  
4 September 11, 2001.
